The teaching for the current session 2018-19 is over and we are sure that your ward will do well in the University examinations. The teaching faculty will remain available in the college for any assistance or clearing the doubts of the students to help them do well in the examinations.

We are pleased to inform that the next academic session 2019-20 would commence from 22/07/2019, hence it is requested to kindly direct your ward to be ensure to get registered for next Academic session as per the procedure mentioned below on/before 22nd July 2019.

Further, the last date to deposit Academic fees for the upcoming session 2019-20 is given below in the table at column no. D. **Please note that partial payment against Academic/ Hostel fee would not be accepted in any way. Hence, you are requested to make arrangement of full fees and deposit the same before the last date.**

Students belonging to SC/ST Category are also required to refer the University direction (copy enclosed) and pay full academic fees accordingly.

After the last date of deposition, the fine would be levied @ Rs. 100/- per day. In case of non-deposition till 15th Aug. 19 (with fine), the admission/registration of your ward would be treated as cancelled.

The payment can be made through one of the following way. After depositing fees, your ward must collect the payment receipt from accounts department. In case of non-collection of academic & hostel receipt, it would be treated as "NON DEPOSITION OF FEES" and fine of Rs. 100/- per day would be applicable from the last date of deposition to till the date of collecting receipt.

- 1) **Bank Draft** in favour of "ABES Engineering College" Payable at Ghaziabad or Delhi. (Detailed information like name, admission no. & mobile No. of the student to be written on the back side of the draft.)
- 2) **PAYTM** (go to PAYTM app, select "ABES Engineering College," choose option 'Academic or Hostel Fee' and pay)

The Registration process is as under:

- 1) Download registration form S-39 from college website <http://www.abes.ac.in/registration> and fill all the fields.
- 2) Attach payment receipt showing full payment made for the session (0 balance).
- 3) Obtain Undertaking of attendance from college website <http://www.abes.ac.in/registration> and attach with form duly signed by you and your ward. Be ensure that your ward would attend 100% classes as no student is permitted to appear in University examination with less than 75% as per University ordinance.
- 4) Attach Anti-rangng undertaking duly signed by you and your ward (fill and take print out from <http://www.amanmovement.org>)
- 5) Attach a copy of Address Proof (in case of any change in the address).
- 6) Submit duly completed Registration Form with all above documents to the concerned department.
